Crisis Intervention Staff are responsible for the following:

- Supervise the daily operations and overall structure of the residents in shelter;
- Interaction with the residents and document said interaction;
- Monitor resident safety and security;
- Maintain facility general operations (cleaning, light maintenance, etc.);
- Maintain structured, educational and supportive environment for residents; and
- Uphold the vision and mission of the organization by adhering to and enforcing policy and procedure.

Candidate(s) must possess the following minimum qualifications to be considered for the position:

- Pass background check and drug screen;
- Minimum of a high school diploma or GED;
- Excellent communication skills, problem solving and critical thinking skills;
- Proven ability to follow instruction and direction with ease;
- Proven ability of task acceptance, completion and follow-through;
- Ability to multi-task and work in a busy environment with little to no supervision; and
- Ability to be productive in an emotionally stressful environment while remaining calm.

Preferred qualifications (but not required):

- Completed courses in social work, psychology, criminal justice or similar field;
- Experience working with victims of domestic violence/sexual assault or experience in public service/non-profit organization;
- CPR and First Aid certification; and
- Knowledge of local, state and federal domestic violence service systems, policies and issues.
